

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS IN
THE TOWN OF TOWNSEND NO. 1-2006

WHEREAS: Pushing snow and or other materials onto or across highways from private driveways can cause accident and death and is prohibited by Wisconsin State Statutes 86.1 and or 346.94(5) and;

WHEREAS: The Townsend Town Board believes it to be in the best interest of the safety of all its citizens to prohibit the obstruction of Town highways by pushing snow or any other injurious substance onto or across a Town highway;

WHEREAS: It is the responsibility of the Townsend Town Board to maintain its roads in a safe and usable manner and that the Town may be held liable under Wisconsin State Statute 82.03;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED: That the pushing of snow or other material onto any Town highway, by any person, so as to obstruct traffic on said highway shall be prohibited.

Any person or persons in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than 10.00 but not more than 100.00 for each offense.
